Persons and Entities Not Registered with TTSEC

The Trinidad and Tobago Securities and Exchange Commission ("TTSEC") is the regulator for the securities industry in Trinidad and Tobago. As part of its mandate to educate the public on the securities industry, we issue this Public Notice ("Notice") to provide investors and the general public with essential information for identifying whether an entity or individual which they are considering investing in might be unregistered.

The TTSEC wishes to bring to the attention of the general public that the following list of persons and entities are **NOT** registered with the TTSEC:

- Kirt Gill
- Core Investment Platform
- Core Investment Trading Platform
- Golden Crest Trade
- Guaranteed Profit Caribbean Trade Exchange
- TT Caribbean Traders
- TT Crest Trade
- TT Trust Caribbean Traders

By law, the above-mentioned persons and entities are not authorised to engage in securities and investment-related activities in Trinidad and Tobago, inclusive of offering securities and investment products for sale; acting as a broker-dealer to facilitate transactions related to securities or investments; and providing investment advice.

Members of the public are strongly advised to always conduct due diligence on any unsolicited communications or advertisements in relation to any investment products or opportunities being offered to ensure that such offerings as well as their promoters are registered with the TTSEC.
