INVESTOR ALERT

The Trinidad and Tobago Securities and Exchange Commission ("the Commission") wishes to remind members of the public that the Commission published a notice to the public on May 2nd 2008 in which it advised that certain investment products are being offered by persons and entities that are not registered with the Commission in any capacity that allows them to offer securities to the public.

The Commission considers it timely and advisable to reiterate its investor alert and wishes to further caution persons who may have been approached to invest or may have invested in products offered by such unregistered companies, to take note of recent developments in relation to some of the principals involved in certain of these offers.

Media reports out of Jamaica, the Turks and Caicos Islands as well as Grenada all indicate that Olint Corporation Limited, Overseas Locket International Corporation and their principals are under investigation by the relevant regulatory authorities within these jurisdictions. As a consequence of these investigations investors in several countries have experienced difficulties in recovering their investments on account of the disruptions caused to their operations.

Members of the public are advised that they should be extremely cautious when considering making investments in any unregistered security offering. If approached by individuals and/or entities that claim to deal in securities, or that offer investment advice, we strongly urge you to ensure that the individual and/or entity is registered with the Commission.
