

Ms. Thomas-Felix is the Commission's third Chairman since its inception in 1997.

Chairman Thomas-Felix is a Hubert Humphrey Fellow who holds a Masters Degree in International Legal Studies from the American University's Washington College of Law. One of her areas of specialization is International Development and Finance Law. Ms Thomas-Felix is currently reading for an Executive Masters in Business Administration at the Arthur Lok Jack Graduate School of Business.

The name Deborah Thomas-Felix has become synonymous with a no-nonsense approach to the dispensation of justice and she has the distinction of being the youngest attorney to be elevated to the bench. She has served as a Magistrate and Senior Magistrate for 11 years in the Criminal and Family Courts and is the first woman to be appointed to the post of Deputy Chief Magistrate. Ms. Thomas-Felix has also served as the first president of the Family Court of St. Vincent and the Grenadines. In September 2009, Ms. Thomas-Felix resigned as a Judge of the Industrial Court of Trinidad and Tobago to go into private practice. She is currently the President of Deborah Thomas-Felix & Associates Attorneys-at-Law and Consultants specializing in Civil Law, Family Law, Criminal Law, Industrial Relations matters, International Arbitration and Environmental Advocacy.

Her experience as a judicial officer as well as in arbitration will assist the Commission in its drive to strengthen its enforcement and judicial role within the securities market.
