PROPOSED REGISTRATION PROCESS – KEY FEATURES

- Applications for registration must be fully <u>completed</u> when submitted to the Commission together with the applicable <u>registration fees.</u>
- 2. Checklists are available on the Commission's website and a copy of the completed or marked off checklist is to be included in the application package.*
- 3. Applicants are asked to submit electronic copies (Microsoft Word) of the application documents (legal and disclosure).



PROPOSED REGISTRATION PROCESS – KEY FEATURES (Continued)

- 4. Applicants are asked to provide the name and email address of the person assigned to be the primary point of contact for the application.
- The Commission to acknowledge receipt within 48 hours.
- 6. The Commission to assign a unique identifying code to each application/matter.
- The Commission to establish timelines for processing matters by category.
